### **Analysis**

#### **Summary**

House Bill 4652 amends Part 26 of the Public Health Code, regarding Data, Information, and Research. The bill adds clarification to the statute regarding the prohibition of the sale, transfer, distribution or gift of an embryo, fetus or neonate for a use that violates Sections 2685 to 2689. The bill adds that the law also applies to any portion of fetal tissue, and that it is also prohibited to collect any fee for the obtaining, processing, transferring, or distribution of an embryo, fetus, fetal tissue, or neonate.
