Analysis

Summary

The bills each would amend the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act to establish a 0.08 percent blood alcohol content as the standard for drunken off-road vehicle (ORV) operation (HB 5130), boating (HB 5131), and snowmobiling (HB 5132), and to make related changes to the relevant statutes.

Fiscal Impact

There are no statewide data available to indicate how the bill might affect numbers of convictions for the various offenses; fiscal impact on state and local correctional systems would depend on how the bills affected charging, plea, and sentencing decisions regarding the offenders involved.
