

# HOUSE BILL No. 4919

June 14, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Waters, Taub and Ward and referred to the Committee on House Oversight, Elections, and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1968 PA 357, entitled

"An act to prescribe the powers, duties and functions of the state officers' compensation commission; and to prescribe the powers and duties of the legislature in relation to the commission,"

by amending sections 3 and 6 (MCL 15.213 and 15.216).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 3. The commission shall meet for not more than 15 session  
2 days beginning after July 1 of every even numbered year and may  
3 reconsider and make a further determination of the mileage  
4 allowance of the members of the legislature who request of the  
5 commission a redetermination. Four members of the commission  
6 constitute a quorum for conducting the business of the commission.  
7 The commission shall not take action or make determinations without  
8 a concurrence of a majority of the members appointed and serving on

1 the commission. The commission shall elect a chairperson from among  
2 its members. The state personnel director shall act as the  
3 secretary to the commission. ~~The commission may establish~~  
4 ~~subcommittees.~~

5       Sec. 6. The commission shall determine the salaries and  
6 expense allowance of the governor, **THE** lieutenant governor, **THE**  
7 **ATTORNEY GENERAL, THE SECRETARY OF STATE,** the justices of the  
8 supreme court, and the members of the legislature and file its  
9 determinations with the clerk of the house of representatives, the  
10 secretary of the senate, and the director of the department of  
11 management and budget after December 1 and before December 31 —  
12 of each even numbered year and shall furnish copies to the  
13 governor, the lieutenant governor, **THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, THE**  
14 **SECRETARY OF STATE, THE** justices of the supreme court, and **THE**  
15 members of the legislature.
