

SENATE BILL No. 575

June 7, 2007, Introduced by Senators BASHAM, SCHAUER, GLEASON and JACOBS and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1990 PA 187, entitled
 "The pupil transportation act,"
 by amending section 9 (MCL 257.1809), as amended by 2006 PA 107.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 9. (1) ~~The state board of education~~ **EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN**
 2 **SUBSECTION (2), THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION** shall
 3 regulate pupil transportation. ~~The state board~~ **SUPERINTENDENT OF**
 4 **PUBLIC INSTRUCTION** or ~~its~~ **HIS OR HER** authorized representative may
 5 review, confirm, set aside, or amend the action, order, or decision
 6 of a school with reference to the routes over which pupils shall be
 7 transported, and the suitability and number of the vehicles and
 8 equipment for the transportation of the pupils. The superintendent
 9 of public instruction shall promulgate rules as necessary to

1 implement this act except that the department of state police, in
2 cooperation with the superintendent of public instruction, may
3 promulgate rules related to vehicle and equipment standards.

4 (2) AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE PARENTS OF THE AFFECTED PUPILS
5 AND THE OWNERSHIP OF A MANUFACTURED HOME PARK, A SCHOOL MAY
6 DETERMINE THE NUMBER AND LOCATION OF STOPS NECESSARY FOR THE
7 RECEIPT AND DISCHARGE OF PUPILS FROM SCHOOL BUSES IN THAT
8 MANUFACTURED HOME PARK.
