

HOUSE BILL No. 5456

September 23, 2009, Introduced by Rep. Miller and referred to the Committee on Ethics and Elections.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 759e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 759E. EACH COUNTY, CITY, TOWNSHIP, AND VILLAGE CLERK
2 SHALL MAINTAIN A PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST. A QUALIFIED AND
3 REGISTERED ELECTOR MAY REQUEST TO BE PLACED ON THE PERMANENT ABSENT
4 VOTER LIST OF THE COUNTY, CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR VILLAGE IN WHICH THE
5 ELECTOR IS REGISTERED TO VOTE. A REQUEST BY AN ELECTOR UNDER THIS
6 SECTION SHALL BE MADE TO THE COUNTY, CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR VILLAGE
7 CLERK IN PERSON OR BY TELEPHONE, FACSIMILE COMMUNICATION, OR FIRST-
8 CLASS MAIL. THE CLERK SHALL SEND TO EACH ELECTOR ON THE PERMANENT
9 ABSENT VOTER LIST AN APPLICATION FOR AN ABSENT VOTER BALLOT FOR

1 EACH ELECTION.
