A bill to amend 2002 PA 733, entitled "State plumbing act,"
by amending section 25 (MCL 338.3535).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 25. (1) The department shall issue a journey plumber's

- 2 license to a person not less than AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AT LEAST 18
- 3 years of age AND who does all of the following:
 - (a) Files a completed application on a form provided by the department.
 - (b) Pays the examination fee prescribed in REQUIRED UNDER section 31 and passes an examination provided for by the board and the department.
- 9 (c) Pays the license fee prescribed in REQUIRED UNDER section 10 31.

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- 1 (d) MEETS EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 2 (i) Has at least 6,000 hours' experience gained over a period
- 3 of not less than AT LEAST 3 years as an apprentice plumber in the
- 4 practical installation of plumbing under the supervision of a
- 5 master plumber.
- 6 (ii) SERVED AS A PLUMBER FOR AT LEAST 2 YEARS WHILE ON ACTIVE
- 7 DUTY AS A MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES AND WAS HONORABLY DISCHARGED
- 8 FROM THAT MILITARY SERVICE IN THE 1-YEAR PERIOD PRECEDING THE DATE
- 9 THE LICENSE APPLICATION IS FILED. AS USED IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH,
- 10 "ARMED FORCES" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE
- 11 VETERAN RIGHT TO EMPLOYMENT SERVICES ACT, 1994 PA 39, MCL 35.1092.
- 12 (2) As a condition of renewal of a journey plumber's license,
- 13 the journey plumber shall demonstrate the successful completion of
- 14 a course, approved by the board, concerning any update or change in
- 15 the code within 12 months after the update or change in that code.
- 16 This requirement applies only during or after those years that the
- 17 code is updated or changed.
