## HOUSE BILL NO. 4395

## A bill to amend 1994 PA 425, entitled

"An act to provide for the creation of community swimming pool authorities; to provide powers and duties of the authorities; to provide for the levy of a tax by the authorities; and to provide for the collection and distribution of the tax,"

by amending section 13 (MCL 123.1073).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 13. (1) An authority formed under this act may levy a tax
- 2 on all of the taxable property in a participating municipality
- 3 located within the district for the purposes of owning or operating
- 4 a community swimming pool.
- 5 (2) The tax authorized in this section shall not exceed 1 mill
- 6 of the state equalized valuation on each dollar of assessed
- 7 valuation of taxable property within the limits of each
- 8 participating municipality.

- 1 (3) The tax authorized under this section shall not be levied
- 2 except upon the approval of a majority of the qualified and
- 3 registered electors of the participating municipalities who reside
- 4 in the district voting on the tax at an annual or special school
- 5 election. The election may be called by resolution of the board.
- 6 The secretary of the board shall file a copy of the resolution of
- 7 the board calling the election with the clerk of any participating
- 8 municipality not less than 70 days LATER THAN 4 P.M. ON THE TWELFTH
- 9 TUESDAY before the date of the election. The resolution calling the
- 10 election shall contain a statement of the proposition to be
- 11 submitted to the electors. All appropriate clerks and all
- 12 appropriate officials shall take all necessary steps to properly
- 13 submit the proposition to the electors of the participating
- 14 municipalities who reside in the district at the election specified
- 15 in the resolution of the authority. The election shall be conducted
- 16 and canvassed in accordance with the Michigan election law, Act No.
- 17 116 of the Public Acts of 1954, being sections 168.1 to 168.992 of
- 18 the Michigan Compiled Laws. 1954 PA 116, MCL 168.1 TO 168.992. The
- 19 results of the election shall be certified to the board promptly
- 20 after the date of the election. No more than 2 elections may be
- 21 held in a calendar year for approval of the tax authorized under
- 22 this section. The authority shall pay its share of the costs of the
- 23 election.
- 24 (4) The taxes authorized by this section may be levied at a
- 25 rate and for a period, not more than 5 years, as determined by the
- 26 authority in the resolution calling the election and as set forth
- in the proposition submitted to the electors.

- 1 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 120 days
- 2 after the date it is enacted into law.
- Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect 3
- unless House Bill No. 4393 of the 97th Legislature is enacted into
- 5 law.
