A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled

"The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 145f.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 145F. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SECTION 145E IS GUILTY OF A 2 CRIME PUNISHABLE AS FOLLOWS:

(A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION (B), THE PERSON IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.

(B) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION OF SECTION 145E, THE PERSON IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.

Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days after the date it is enacted into law.
