

SENATE BILL No. 925

May 1, 2014, Introduced by Senators JONES, BIEDA, ROBERTSON, HOPGOOD, BRANDENBURG, ROCCA, KOWALL, HUNE, ANDERSON, EMMONS and SCHUITMAKER and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 145f.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 145F. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SECTION 145E IS GUILTY OF A
2 CRIME PUNISHABLE AS FOLLOWS:

3 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION (B), THE PERSON IS
4 GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE
5 THAN 90 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.

6 (B) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION OF SECTION 145E, THE
7 PERSON IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR
8 NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.

9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
10 after the date it is enacted into law.

1 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
2 unless Senate Bill No. 924
3 of the 97th Legislature is enacted into law.
