

SENATE BILL No. 1165

December 4, 2014, Introduced by Senator ROBERTSON and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Elections.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
by amending section 590f (MCL 168.590f), as amended by 2002 PA 163.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 590f. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3),
2 sections 544c, 545, **547**, 552, 553, 555, 556, and 558 are applicable
3 to a qualifying petition, a person filing a qualifying petition,
4 and an officer receiving a qualifying petition.

5 (2) The board of state canvassers shall canvass a qualifying
6 petition filed with the secretary of state and shall make an
7 official declaration of the sufficiency or insufficiency of the
8 qualifying petition at least 60 days before the election. A hearing
9 under this subsection by the board of state canvassers shall be
10 held as provided in section 552.

1 (3) A filing officer who receives a qualifying petition from a
2 candidate who has met the requirements of this act shall certify to
3 the proper board or boards of election commissioners the
4 candidate's name, post office address, and office sought. If the
5 election for the office is held at the general election, the filing
6 officer shall make the certification not later than 60 days before
7 the general election.

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
9 unless all of the following bills of the 97th Legislature are
10 enacted into law:
