ADULTS. THE REPORT SHALL BE PROVIDED TO THE LEGISLATURE

- 25 (B) A JUVENILE'S EDUCATIONAL AND SCHOOL HISTORY INCLUDING
- 26 SCHOOLS ATTENDED, GRADES COMPLETED, AND SUSPENSIONS OR EXPULSIONS.
