A bill to amend 2013 PA 240, entitled "Michigan state capitol historic site act," by amending section 6 (MCL 4.1946).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6. (1) The commission shall do all of the following:
- 2 (a) Subject to subsection (2), operate and manage the Michigan3 state capitol historic site.
 - (b) Maintain and restore the state capitol building.
 - (c) Maintain and improve the grounds of the Michigan state capitol historic site.
 - (d) Appoint an individual to manage the day-to-day operations of the Michigan state capitol historic site. The individual appointed under this subdivision is an at-will employee and shall

- 1 serve SERVES at the pleasure of the commission.
- 2 (e) Employ staff to carry out the commission's
