

HOUSE BILL No. 4672

June 2, 2015, Introduced by Reps. Singh, Moss, Gay-Dagnogo, Pagan, Yanez, Faris and Wittenberg and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled
"Michigan vehicle code,"
(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 676e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 676E. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT POSSESS A LIT TOBACCO
2 PRODUCT IN A MOTOR VEHICLE IF AN INDIVIDUAL LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF
3 AGE IS OCCUPYING THE MOTOR VEHICLE.

4 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS RESPONSIBLE FOR A
5 CIVIL INFRACTION AND MAY BE ORDERED TO PAY A FINE OF \$500.00.

6 (3) POINTS SHALL NOT BE ASSESSED UNDER SECTION 320A FOR A
7 VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.

8 (4) FOR 1 YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT
9 THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION SHALL
10 BE ISSUED A WARNING, BUT NOT BE CITED FOR THE VIOLATION.

11 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "TOBACCO PRODUCT" MEANS THAT TERM
