## **HOUSE BILL No. 5568**

April 19, 2016, Introduced by Rep. McCready and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled

"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

by amending section 517a (MCL 436.1517a), as added by 2004 PA 170.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 517a. (1) The commission may issue national sporting
 event licenses for the sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on
 the premises concerning a national sporting event, if THE
 COMMISSION FINDS all of the following circumstances are found by
 the commission to exist:

6 (a) The local governmental unit in which the national sporting
7 event is to be conducted is the host governmental unit for that THE
8 NATIONAL SPORTING event.

(b) The premises to be licensed are located in a theme area or

1 theme areas designated by the governing body of the host

2 governmental unit in connection with the national sporting event or 3 are operated in conjunction with that THE NATIONAL SPORTING event.

4 (c) The commission determines that the national sporting event
5 will attract a substantial number of tourists from outside this
6 state.

7 (d) The national sporting event is conducted under the8 auspices of a national sanctioning body.

(e) The applicant is any of the following:

10 (i) A Michigan licensee for the sale of alcoholic liquor for11 consumption on the premises.

12 (*ii*) The promoter of the national sporting event or an13 affiliate of the promoter.

14 (*iii*) A person who has entered into a written concession or 15 catering agreement with the promoter of the national sporting event 16 or its affiliate, which agreement has been approved by the 17 commission.

18 (*iv*) An organization qualified for licensure as a special 19 licensee under section <del>111(10)</del>-**111(11)** and the rules of the 20 commission.

(2) Licenses A LICENSE issued under this section shall MUST be
for a period of not more than 30 consecutive days and are IS not
transferable as to ownership or location. The license shall MUST be
for specific designated time periods that include the national
sporting event and activities associated with the national sporting
event.

(3) Not more than 40 licenses shall MAY be issued under this

1 section for use at the same time in a theme area or theme areas.

2 (4) The governing body of a host governmental unit described 3 in subsection (1) shall supply to the commission for the 4 commission's review a list containing the names of applicants and 5 the locations of the premises to be licensed under this section. 6 The governing body of the host governmental unit shall recommend the number of licenses to be issued pursuant to UNDER this section 7 in the theme area or theme areas. The commission shall not issue 8 any licenses pursuant to A LICENSE UNDER this section that are IS 9 10 not recommended by the governing body of the host governmental 11 unit.

12 (5) The governing body of the host governmental unit shall 13 provide, in conjunction with the list described in subsection (4), 14 written certification to the commission that all premises to be 15 licensed under this section comply with applicable state and local 16 building, safety, and health laws, rules, and regulations.

17 (6) A license issued pursuant to UNDER this section is not
18 subject to section 503.

19 (7) An applicant for a license under this section shall pay to
20 the commission a license fee of \$1,000.00 at the time of
21 application.

(8) As used in this section, "national sporting event" means a
sports related event considered of national prominence and includes
only the following:

25 (a) The major league baseball all-star game MAJOR LEAGUE
26 BASEBALL ALL-STAR GAME during calendar year 2005.

(b) The national football league super bowl NATIONAL FOOTBALL
