

HOUSE BILL No. 6107

December 6, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Lucido, Kosowski, Howrylak, Santana and Liberati and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding sections 20969a and 21527a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 20969A. (1) IF A MEDICAL FIRST RESPONDER, EMERGENCY
2 MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN SPECIALIST, OR
3 PARAMEDIC WHO IS PROVIDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TO AN
4 INDIVIDUAL RECEIVES INFORMATION THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN THE
5 VICTIM OF AN ASSAULTIVE CRIME, THE MEDICAL FIRST RESPONDER,
6 EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN
7 SPECIALIST, OR PARAMEDIC SHALL PROVIDE THE INDIVIDUAL INFORMATION
8 ORALLY AND IN WRITING REGARDING THE LOCATION OF AND SERVICES
9 OFFERED BY CRIME SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY CENTERS ESTABLISHED UNDER
10 THE CRIME SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY CENTER ACT.
11 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "ASSAULTIVE CRIME" MEANS THAT

3 SEC. 21527A. (1) IF AN INDIVIDUAL ALLEGES TO A PHYSICIAN OR
4 OTHER MEMBER OF THE ATTENDING OR ADMITTING STAFF OF A HOSPITAL THAT
5 HE OR SHE HAS BEEN THE VICTIM OF AN ASSAULTIVE CRIME, THE ATTENDING
6 HEALTH CARE PERSONNEL RESPONSIBLE FOR EXAMINING OR TREATING THE
7 INDIVIDUAL SHALL PROVIDE THE INDIVIDUAL INFORMATION ORALLY AND IN
8 WRITING REGARDING THE LOCATION OF AND SERVICES OFFERED BY CRIME
9 SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY CENTERS ESTABLISHED UNDER THE CRIME
10 SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY CENTER ACT.

11 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "ASSAULTIVE CRIME" MEANS THAT
12 TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 9A OF CHAPTER X OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL
13 PROCEDURE, 1927 PA 175, MCL 770.9A.

14 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
15 after the date it is enacted into law.

16 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
17 unless Senate Bill No.____ or House Bill No.6106 (request no.
18 06531'16) of the 98th Legislature is enacted into law.
