HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION VV

December 1, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Driskell, Brinks, Schor, Wittenberg, Hovey-Wright, Lane and Lauren Plawecki and referred to the Committee on Elections.

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by amending section 7 of article IV, to require that each candidate for state senator or state representative be an elector of the district he or she will represent for at least 60 days before the filing deadline.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to require that each candidate for state senator or state representative be an elector of the district he or she will represent for at least 60 days before the filing deadline, is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

1 ARTICLE IV

2 Sec. 7. Each senator and representative must be a citizen of 3 the United States, at least 21 years of age, and an elector of the
