A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled “Michigan vehicle code,” by amending sections 904 and 904a (MCL 257.904 and 257.904a), section 904 as amended by 2015 PA 11 and section 904a as amended by 1985 PA 53.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Law and Justice.

House Bill No. 4043, entitled

A bill to amend 2012 PA 176, entitled “Mozelle senior or vulnerable adult medical alert act,” (MCL 28.711 to 28.718) by amending the title and by adding section 2a.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Law and Justice.

A bill to amend 2011 PA 256, entitled “Michigan fireworks safety act,” by amending section 7 (MCL 28.457), as amended by 2013 PA 65.

A bill to amend 1990 PA 187, entitled “The pupil transportation act,” (MCL 257.1801 to 257.1877) by adding section 22. The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

House Bill No. 4046, entitled

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled “The revised school code,” by amending section 1212 (MCL 380.1212), as amended by 2016 PA 319.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

Rep. Whiteford introduced

House Bill No. 4047, entitled

A bill to amend 1893 PA 206, entitled “The general property tax act,” (MCL 211.1 to 211.155) by adding section 9p. The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

House Bill No. 4048, entitled

A bill to amend 1885 PA 152, entitled “An act to authorize the establishment of facilities for former members of the armed forces of the United States in the state of Michigan; to create funds; and to provide for the promulgation of rules,” (MCL 36.1 to 36.12) by adding section 11a.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend 2001 PA 142, entitled "Michigan memorial highway act," (MCL 250.1001 to 250.2080) by adding section 7a.

House Bill No. 4058, entitled

A bill to amend 1992 PA 147, entitled "Neighborhood enterprise zone act," by amending section 13 (MCL 207.783), as amended by 2005 PA 339; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

House Bill No. 4059, entitled
