

HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 1234

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 20925.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 20925. THIS PART DOES NOT PROHIBIT AN AMBULANCE FROM
2 PROVIDING EMERGENCY TRANSPORT OF A POLICE DOG THAT IS INJURED IN
3 THE LINE OF DUTY TO A VETERINARY CLINIC OR SIMILAR FACILITY, IF THE
4 POLICE DOG IS IN NEED OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL TREATMENT AND THERE ARE
5 NO INDIVIDUALS WHO REQUIRE TRANSPORT OR EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE AT
6 THAT TIME. AMBULANCE PERSONNEL MAY REQUIRE THAT A POLICE OFFICER
7 ACCOMPANY THE POLICE DOG DURING THE EMERGENCY TRANSPORT. AS USED IN
8 THIS SECTION, "POLICE DOG" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION
9 50C OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.50C.

10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days

1 after the date it is enacted into law.
