HOUSE BILL No. 4444

March 30, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Whiteford, Crawford, Allor, Victory and Rendon and referred to the Committee on Communications and Technology.

A bill to require certain coordination between construction projects in rights-of-way and installation of broadband facilities; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- (a) "Broadband service" means that term as defined in section
 102 of the Michigan telecommunications act, 1991 PA 179, MCL
 484.2102.
 - (b) "Broadband conduit" means a conduit, pipe, innerduct, or microduct for fiber optic or other cables that support broadband and wireless facilities for broadband service.
 - (c) "Commission" means the Michigan public service commission created in section 1 of 1939 PA 3, MCL 460.1.

- 1 (d) "Local unit of government" means a city, county, county
- 2 road commission, or village.
- 3 Sec. 2. (1) The commission shall, in collaboration with the
- 4 state transportation department and private entities, encourage and

- 6 improvement of broadband conduit within any right-of-way under the
- 7 jurisdiction of the state transportation department in conjunction
- 8 with any current or planned construction in that right-of-way.
