

HOUSE BILL No. 5038

September 28, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Crawford and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding sections 17019 and 17519.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **SEC. 17019. (1) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2018, A PHYSICIAN WHO**
2 **SPECIALIZES IN PRIMARY CARE SHALL INCLUDE ON THE PHYSICIAN'S**
3 **PATIENT INTAKE FORM QUESTIONS THAT ARE ENDORSED BY THE UNITED**
4 **STATES PREVENTATIVE SERVICE TASK FORCE OR THE NATIONAL**
5 **COMPREHENSIVE CANCER NETWORK AND ARE DESIGNED TO IDENTIFY A PATIENT**
6 **WHO HAS A FAMILY HISTORY THAT MAY BE ASSOCIATED WITH AN INCREASED**
7 **RISK OF HEREDITARY BREAST OR OVARIAN CANCER.**

8 **(2) IF A PATIENT'S RESPONSE TO 1 OR MORE OF THE QUESTIONS**
9 **DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) INDICATES A FAMILY HISTORY THAT MAY BE**
10 **ASSOCIATED WITH AN INCREASED RISK OF HEREDITARY BREAST OR OVARIAN**

1 CANCER, THE PHYSICIAN SHALL PROVIDE THE PATIENT WITH INFORMATION ON
2 GENETIC COUNSELING FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER GENETIC
3 TESTING FOR MUTATIONS IN GENES ASSOCIATED WITH BREAST AND OVARIAN
4 CANCER IS APPROPRIATE FOR THE PATIENT.

5 SEC. 17519. (1) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2018, A PHYSICIAN WHO
6 SPECIALIZES IN PRIMARY CARE SHALL INCLUDE ON THE PHYSICIAN'S
7 PATIENT INTAKE FORM QUESTIONS THAT ARE ENDORSED BY THE UNITED
8 STATES PREVENTATIVE SERVICE TASK FORCE OR THE NATIONAL
9 COMPREHENSIVE CANCER NETWORK AND ARE DESIGNED TO IDENTIFY A PATIENT
10 WHO HAS A FAMILY HISTORY THAT MAY BE ASSOCIATED WITH AN INCREASED
11 RISK OF HEREDITARY BREAST OR OVARIAN CANCER.

12 (2) IF A PATIENT'S RESPONSE TO 1 OR MORE OF THE QUESTIONS

19 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
20 after the date it is enacted into law.
