June 6, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Lilly and LaSata and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
 "The code of criminal procedure,"  
 by amending section 11d of chapter XVII (MCL 777.11d), as amended  
 by 2018 PA 124.
