

# HOUSE BILL No. 6146

June 12, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Green, Sowerby, Zemke, Yanez, Pagan, Geiss, Chang, Camilleri, Faris, Gay-Dagnogo and Jones and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Trade.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled  
"The social welfare act,"  
(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 104.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           **SEC. 104. (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ANNUALLY, NOT LATER THAN**  
2           **FEBRUARY 1, PREPARE AND SUBMIT A PUBLIC HEALTH PROGRAM BENEFICIARY**  
3           **EMPLOYER REPORT TO IDENTIFY THE 50 EMPLOYERS THAT HAVE THE HIGHEST**  
4           **NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES WHO RECEIVE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS ACT.**  
5           **THE REPORT MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE SENATE MAJORITY LEADER, THE**  
6           **SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE CHAIRS OF THE SENATE**  
7           **AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEES, THE CHAIRS**  
8           **OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES APPROPRIATIONS**  
9           **SUBCOMMITTEES ON THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES**

1 BUDGET, AND THE CHAIRS OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
2 STANDING COMMITTEES ON HEALTH POLICY. THE REPORT MUST ALSO BE MADE  
3 AVAILABLE ON THE DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE.

4 (2) THE REPORT MUST INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

5 (A) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE EMPLOYER.

6 (B) THE SIZE OF THE EMPLOYER.

7 (C) THE NUMBER OF MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM RECIPIENTS WHO  
8 ARE AN EMPLOYEE OF THAT EMPLOYER.

9 (D) THE NUMBER OF MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM RECIPIENTS WHO  
10 ARE A SPOUSE OR DEPENDENT OF AN EMPLOYEE OF THAT EMPLOYER.

11 (E) WHETHER THE EMPLOYER OFFERS HEALTH BENEFITS TO ITS  
12 EMPLOYEES.

13 (F) THE COST TO THE STATE OF PROVIDING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE  
14 PROGRAM BENEFITS FOR THE EMPLOYER'S EMPLOYEES AND ENROLLED  
15 DEPENDENTS, IF AVAILABLE.

16 (G) WHETHER THE EMPLOYER OFFERED HEALTH BENEFITS TO ITS  
17 EMPLOYEES WHO ARE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM RECIPIENTS AND, IF SO,  
18 THE NUMBER OF THOSE EMPLOYEES.

19 (3) THE REPORT SHALL NOT INCLUDE THE NAME OF ANY INDIVIDUAL  
20 MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM RECIPIENT AND IS SUBJECT TO PRIVACY  
21 STANDARDS ACCORDING TO THE HEALTH INSURANCE PORTABILITY AND  
22 ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 1996, PUBLIC LAW 104-191. THE DEPARTMENT MAY  
23 ESTABLISH INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS TO COLLECT INFORMATION TO FULFILL  
24 THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

25 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
26 after the date it is enacted into law.
