

# HOUSE BILL No. 6359

September 25, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Calley, Yaroch and Hughes and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled  
"Michigan vehicle code,"  
(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 811ii.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           **SEC. 811II. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER**  
2           **SECTION 811E AND ISSUE UNDER SECTION 811F A FUND-RAISING PLATE**  
3           **RECOGNIZING THE SCHOOL EMERGENCY RESPONSE COALITION. A FUND-RAISING**  
4           **PLATE DEVELOPED UNDER THIS SECTION MUST BE OF A DESIGN DETERMINED**  
5           **BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.**

6           **(2) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY**  
7           **FROM THE SALE OF FUND-RAISING PLATES RECOGNIZING THE SCHOOL**  
8           **EMERGENCY RESPONSE COALITION COLLECTED UNDER SECTION 811F TO THE**  
9           **STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE DONATION MONEY TO THE SCHOOL**  
10          **EMERGENCY RESPONSE COALITION FUND CREATED IN SUBSECTION (3).**

1           (3) THE SCHOOL EMERGENCY RESPONSE COALITION FUND IS CREATED  
2 WITHIN THE STATE TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR  
3 OTHER ASSETS FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE  
4 TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE  
5 TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND  
6 INVESTMENTS.

7           (4) MONEY IN THE SCHOOL EMERGENCY RESPONSE COALITION FUND AT  
8 THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR MUST REMAIN IN THE FUND AND MUST NOT  
9 LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

10           (5) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE SCHOOL  
11 EMERGENCY RESPONSE COALITION FUND ON A MONTHLY BASIS TO THE SCHOOL  
12 EMERGENCY RESPONSE COALITION.

13           (6) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL BE THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE  
14 SCHOOL EMERGENCY RESPONSE COALITION FUND FOR AUDITING PURPOSES.

15           (7) MONEY FROM THE SCHOOL EMERGENCY RESPONSE COALITION FUND  
16 MUST ONLY BE USED OR EXPENDED FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS OR  
17 PURPOSES:

18           (A) THE PURCHASE OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS FOR  
19 ENTITIES THAT DO NOT HAVE AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS OR FOR  
20 ENTITIES THAT CANNOT AFFORD AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS.

21           (B) THE PURCHASE OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR PADS OR  
22 ELECTRODE PADS.

23           (C) THE PURCHASE OF BATTERIES FOR AUTOMATED EXTERNAL  
24 DEFIBRILLATORS.

25           (D) THE PURCHASE OF TRAINING MANNEQUINS.

26           (E) A CONTRIBUTION TO THE SCHOOL EMERGENCY RESPONSE  
27 COALITION'S CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION PROGRAM.

1           (F) A CONTRIBUTION FOR STUDENTS TO BE TRAINED TO BECOME  
2 STUDENTS UNITED PREPARED EMERGENCY RESPONDERS.

3           (8) MONEY FROM THE SCHOOL EMERGENCY RESPONSE COALITION FUND  
4 MUST NOT BE USED FOR ANY ADMINISTRATIVE PURPOSES.

5           Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
6 after the date it is enacted into law.
