

# SENATE BILL No. 939

April 12, 2018, Introduced by Senators BIEDA, JONES, HOPGOOD, GREGORY, HERTEL and KNEZEK and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1967 PA 150, entitled "Michigan military act," by amending section 411 (MCL 32.811), as amended by 2000 PA 472.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 411. (1) ~~A person~~ **AN INDIVIDUAL** who has completed not  
2 less than 20 years of active service with the ~~national guard~~  
3 **NATIONAL GUARD** or defense force, or both, may retire and receive  
4 retirement pay under 1 or more of the following circumstances:

5           (a) ~~Attainment of~~ **THE INDIVIDUAL IS** 62 years of age **OR OLDER**.

6           (b) Ineligibility, because of federal law or regulation, for  
7 further federal recognition in the ~~person's~~ **INDIVIDUAL'S** current  
8 grade because of age or length of service, and termination of the  
9 ~~person's~~ **INDIVIDUAL'S** commission or enlistment in the ~~national~~  
10 ~~guard~~ **NATIONAL GUARD** of the United States.

1 (c) Withdrawal of the ~~person's~~ **INDIVIDUAL'S** federal  
2 recognition and termination of the ~~person's~~ **INDIVIDUAL'S** commission  
3 or enlistment in the ~~national guard~~ **NATIONAL GUARD** of the United  
4 States because of physical disqualification from further service.

5 (d) ~~Separation~~ **THE INDIVIDUAL SEPARATES** from the ~~national~~  
6 ~~guard~~ **NATIONAL GUARD** or defense force under an honorable  
7 circumstance.

8 (2) ~~A person~~ **AN INDIVIDUAL** who retires under subsection (1)(a)  
9 shall receive pay of ~~\$600.00~~ **\$1,200.00** per year. ~~A person~~ **AN**  
10 **INDIVIDUAL** who retires under subsection (1)(b), (c), or (d) shall  
11 receive pay of ~~\$600.00~~ **\$1,200.00** per year upon ~~reaching~~ **ATTAINING**  
12 55 years of age.

13 (3) Upon the death of ~~a person~~ **AN INDIVIDUAL** who has completed  
14 not less than 20 years of active service with the ~~national guard~~  
15 **NATIONAL GUARD** or defense force, or both, and who before his or her  
16 death met 1 of the circumstances described in subsection (1)(b),  
17 (c), or (d), or was still in active service, ~~a~~ **THE INDIVIDUAL'S**  
18 surviving spouse shall receive ~~\$500.00~~ **\$1,200.00** per year until  
19 death.
