

# SENATE BILL No. 983

May 3, 2018, Introduced by Senator KNOLLENBERG and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled  
"The revised school code,"  
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1308a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1           SEC. 1308A. (1) BEGINNING IN THE 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR, AND AT  
2 LEAST BIENNIALY THEREAFTER, A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL  
3 DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL, IN CONJUNCTION WITH A  
4 LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, CONDUCT A SCHOOL SAFETY ASSESSMENT  
5 FOR EACH SCHOOL BUILDING OPERATED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT,  
6 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY.

7           (2) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (3), NOT LATER THAN JANUARY 1, 2020,  
8 A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL  
9 ACADEMY SHALL DEVELOP AN EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN FOR EACH SCHOOL  
10 BUILDING OPERATED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL

1 DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY WITH INPUT FROM THE PUBLIC. THE  
2 BOARD OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR THE  
3 BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ADOPT THE  
4 EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE MEMBERS SERVING  
5 ON THE BOARD OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS AT A PUBLIC MEETING OF THE BOARD  
6 OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS HELD IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS  
7 ACT, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 TO 15.275.

8 (3) THE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN DEVELOPED AND ADOPTED UNDER  
9 SUBSECTION (2) MUST INCLUDE GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES THAT ADDRESS  
10 AT LEAST ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

11 (A) SCHOOL VIOLENCE AND ATTACKS.

12 (B) THREATS OF SCHOOL VIOLENCE AND ATTACKS.

13 (C) BOMB THREATS.

14 (D) FIRE.

15 (E) WEATHER-RELATED EMERGENCIES.

16 (F) INTRUDERS.

17 (G) PARENT AND PUPIL REUNIFICATION.

18 (H) THREATS TO A SCHOOL-SPONSORED ACTIVITY OR EVENT WHETHER OR  
19 NOT IT IS HELD ON SCHOOL PREMISES.

20 (I) A PLAN TO TRAIN TEACHERS ON MENTAL HEALTH AND PUPIL AND  
21 TEACHER SAFETY.

22 (J) A PLAN TO IMPROVE SCHOOL BUILDING SECURITY.

23 (K) AN ACTIVE SHOOTER PROTOCOL.

24 (4) A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC  
25 SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL PROVIDE NOTICE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF A  
26 COMPLETED SCHOOL SAFETY ASSESSMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (1) NOT LATER  
27 THAN 30 DAYS AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE SCHOOL SAFETY ASSESSMENT,

1 IN A FORM AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT. A SCHOOL  
2 DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY  
3 SHALL ALSO PROVIDE NOTICE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ADOPTION OF AN  
4 EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN UNDER SUBSECTION (2) NOT LATER THAN 30  
5 DAYS AFTER THE ADOPTION OF THE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN, IN A FORM  
6 AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

7 (5) AT LEAST ANNUALLY, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL POST ON ITS  
8 WEBSITE A LIST OF EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL  
9 DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY THAT HAS NOT DEVELOPED AND  
10 ADOPTED AN EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN UNDER SUBSECTION (2).

11 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "SCHOOL BUILDING" MEANS ANY OF  
12 THE FOLLOWING:

13 (A) A BUILDING INTENDED TO BE USED TO PROVIDE INSTRUCTION FOR  
14 PUPILS, INCLUDING AN ADDITION TO AN EXISTING BUILDING.

15 (B) A RECREATIONAL OR ATHLETIC STRUCTURE OR FIELD INTENDED TO  
16 BE USED BY PUPILS.

17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
18 after the date it is enacted into law.
