

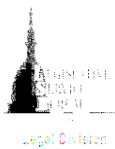
HOUSE BILL NO. 4833

August 28, 2019, Introduced by Rep. Albert and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 1988 PA 466, entitled
"Animal industry act,"
by amending section 30a (MCL 287.730a), as amended by 2002 PA 458.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 30a. (1) ~~Privately owned cervids, except those consigned~~
2 ~~directly to a state or federally inspected slaughter facility~~
3 ~~premises, shall not be imported~~ **Subject to subsection (2), the**
4 **following apply to a privately owned cervid imported into this**
5 **state:**



1 **(a) A person shall not import a live cervid** into this state
2 unless **it is** accompanied by an official interstate health
3 certificate or official interstate certificate of veterinary
4 inspection.

5 **(b) If a live cervid is consigned directly to a state or**
6 **federally inspected slaughter facility premises, a person may**
7 **import the cervid into this state without either of the**
8 **certificates described in subdivision (a).**

9 **(2) Beginning on the effective date of the 2019 amendatory act**
10 **that added this subsection, a person shall not do either of the**
11 **following:**

12 **(a) Import into this state a live cervid from a region, as**
13 **defined by the department, in which a cervid has tested positive**
14 **for chronic wasting disease in the preceding 10 years. The**
15 **department shall post on its website a list of regions in which a**
16 **cervid has tested positive for chronic wasting disease. The posting**
17 **must include a statement indicating that importation of a live**
18 **cervid from a listed region is prohibited.**

19 **(b) Transport a live cervid into or out of a local unit of**
20 **government in this state that the department has identified as an**
21 **area in which a cervid has tested positive for chronic wasting**
22 **disease. The department shall post on its website a list of local**
23 **units of government in which a cervid has tested positive for**
24 **chronic wasting disease. The posting must include a statement**
25 **indicating that transportation of a live cervid into or out of a**
26 **listed local unit of government is prohibited. As used in this**
27 **subdivision, "local unit of government" means a township, village,**
28 **or city.**

2 (7) ~~(6) Privately~~ **A privately** owned ~~cervids~~ **cervid** with a
3 response other than negative to ~~any~~ **a** tuberculosis ~~test~~ or
4 brucellosis test ~~are~~ **is** not eligible for interstate movement into
5 this state ~~without permission from~~ **unless permitted by** the
6 director.

7 (8) ~~(7) Privately~~ **A privately** owned ~~cervids~~ **cervid** known to be
8 affected with or exposed to tuberculosis or brucellosis ~~are~~ **is** not
9 eligible for interstate movement into this state ~~without permission~~
10 ~~from~~ **unless permitted by** the director.

11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
12 after the date it is enacted into law.
