

HOUSE BILL NO. 5891

June 23, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Calley and Albert and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 499.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **Sec. 499. (1) A person who knowingly and willfully raises a**
2 **false active shooter alarm in a public place, including, but not**
3 **limited to, a school, is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by**
4 **imprisonment for not more than 1 year and a fine of not more than**
5 **\$1,000.00.**



1 (2) As used in this section, "active shooter alarm" means an
2 alarm system that is designed to alert individuals inside that
3 place, that there is an active shooter on or near the premises,
4 including an alarm system that when activated locks doors, informs
5 local law enforcement of the active shooter, flashes a blue light,
6 and broadcasts a message inside the place indicating the presence
7 of an active shooter.

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
9 after the date it is enacted into law.
