"An act to regulate the time and manner of payment of wages and fringe benefits to employees; to prescribe rights and responsibilities of employers and employees, and the powers and duties of the department of labor; to require keeping of records; to provide for settlement of disputes regarding wages and fringe benefits; to prohibit certain practices by employers; to prescribe penalties and remedies; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 15 (MCL 408.485).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 15. An employer who, with the intent to defraud, fails to

- 2 as provided in this act , is guilty of a misdemeanor, crime
- 3 punishable as follows:
- 4 (a) For a first violation, a misdemeanor punishable by
- 5 imprisonment for not more than 1 year or a fine of not more than
- 6 \$1,000.00, or imprisonment for not more than 1 year, or both.
- 7 (b) For a second or subsequent violation, a felony punishable
- 8 by imprisonment for not more than 2 years or a fine of not more
- 9 than \$10,000.00, or both.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
