October 08, 2019, Introduced by Senator STAMAS and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for various state departments and agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

11 Sec. 201. In accordance with section 30 of article IX of the
12 state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources
13 in this appropriation act for the fiscal year ending September 30,
14 2020 is \$1,875,000.00 and state spending from state sources to be
15 paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

16 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
17 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
18 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are
19 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
20 to 18.1594.

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

23 Sec. 301. From the funds appropriated in part 1 for health
24 plan services and physician services, the department shall provide
25 Medicaid reimbursement rates for neonatal services at 95% of the
26 Medicare rate received for those services in effect on the date the
27 services are provided to eligible Medicaid recipients. The current
28 procedural terminology (CPT) codes that are eligible for this
29 reimbursement rate increase are 99468, 99469, 99471, 99472, 99475,

1 99476, 99477, 99478, 99479, and 99480.
