## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.22

Rep. Garrett, Ellison, Haadsma, Kuppa, Liberati, Manoogian, Shannon, Sneller and Sowerby offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to declare February 2019 as Transparency in
- 2 Government Month in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, Transparency in Government Month calls attention to
- 4 the fact that the government has an obligation to its citizens to
- 5 share information; and
- 6 Whereas, Governments exist to serve their citizens. Therefore,
- 7 their citizens should receive information on what their
- 8 representatives are doing, how their officials are spending
- 9 taxpayers' money, and how their government is handling various
- 10 issues; and
- 11 Whereas, In 2015, a study by the Center of Public Integrity

- 1 ranked Michigan last among all the states concerning government
- 2 accountability and transparency. A lack of government transparency
- 3 creates mistrust and frustration and increases the risk for
- 4 corruption. The absence of government transparency impacts every
- 5 person in Michigan; and
- 6 Whereas, Government transparency fosters government
- 7 participation, promotes good governance, improves government
- 8 efficiency and effectiveness, and combats corruption. Information
- 9 on the activities and policies of government allows the public to
- 10 participate in the democratic process and hold their government
- 11 accountable and allows residents to influence the decisions
- 12 affecting their lives and encourage their representatives to use
- 13 their power to affect change. Knowledge of government decisions and
- 14 processes empowers Michiganders to give feedback on how policies
- 15 are working in practice and how the allocation of government
- 16 resources can be improved. Access to information increases the
- 17 likelihood of discovering corrupt practices, acting as a deterrent
- 18 to corruption in the future; and
- 19 Whereas, Our state and local governments must be committed to
- 20 government transparency and accountability. When we actively
- 21 increase information between the government and its citizens, we
- 22 can foster good governance, improve government efficiency, and
- 23 combat corruption. We must work together to promote information
- 24 flowing freely between our government and its citizens; now,
- 25 therefore, be it
- 26 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 27 this legislative body declare February 2019 as Transparency in
- 28 Government Month in the state of Michigan. We strongly support the
- 29 efforts of national, state, and local partners to actively engage

1 in efforts to encourage government transparency.
