SUMMARY:

House Bill 4332 would amend Part 811 (Off-Road Recreation Vehicles) of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act to allow the license for a two-wheel off-road vehicle (ORV) to be placed either centered on the exposed surface of the rear fender or located at a visible place on a front suspension fork.

Currently under the act and Department of Natural Resources rules, an ORV license for a two-wheel vehicle must be centered on the exposed surface of the rear fender.¹ (Below is an image provided by Offroad Ed indicating the current license placement requirement.²)

The bill would also allow the license to be located at a visible place on a front suspension fork.

Two-wheel vehicle: center the ORV sticker on the exposed rear fender.



FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 4332 is unlikely to affect costs or revenues for the Department of Natural Resources or local units of government.
