

**SUBSTITUTE FOR  
HOUSE BILL NO. 4687**

A bill to amend 1978 PA 472, entitled  
"An act to regulate political activity; to regulate lobbyists,  
lobbyist agents, and lobbying activities; to require registration  
of lobbyists and lobbyist agents; to require the filing of reports;  
to prescribe the powers and duties of the department of state; to  
prescribe penalties; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"  
by amending section 6a (MCL 4.416a), as added by 1994 PA 383.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 6a. (1) A member of the Michigan senate or house of  
2 representatives who resigns from office **before January 1, 2023**  
3 shall not make expenditures for or receive compensation or  
4 reimbursement for actual expenses for lobbying for the remainder of  
5 the term of office from which the person resigned.

6           **(2) For 2 years after leaving or resigning from office, a**

1 former member of the Michigan senate or house of representatives  
2 shall not make expenditures for or receive compensation or  
3 reimbursement for actual expenses for lobbying that equal or exceed  
4 the limit established to require registration as a lobbyist agent.  
5 This subsection applies to a member whose term of office begins on  
6 or after January 1, 2023.

7 (3) ~~(2) A person~~ **An individual** who violates this section is  
8 guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by ~~a fine of not more than~~  
9 ~~\$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days~~ **or a fine of**  
10 **not more than \$1,000.00, or both.**
