

HOUSE BILL NO. 6484

November 09, 2022, Introduced by Rep. Steven Johnson and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Municipal Finance.

A bill to preempt certain local ordinances that relate to pelts, furs, or products manufactured from pelts or furs.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:

2 (a) "Fur" means a pelt or fur or a product manufactured in
3 whole or part from a pelt or fur.

4 (b) "Local unit of government" means a county, city, village,
5 or township.

6 Sec. 3. A local unit of government shall not adopt or enforce
7 an ordinance that does any of the following:

- 1 (a) Regulates the use, disposition, or sale of fur.
- 2 (b) Prohibits or restricts the ownership of fur.
- 3 (c) Imposes a fee, charge, or tax on fur.
