

# SENATE BILL NO. 134

February 16, 2021, Introduced by Senator VANDERWALL and referred to the Committee on Health Policy and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled  
"The Michigan penal code,"  
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 410c.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           **Sec. 410c. (1) A person shall not distribute, deliver, sell,**  
2           **or possess with intent to distribute, deliver, or sell a drug**  
3           **masking product.**

4           **(2) Except as provided in subsection (3), a person who**  
5           **violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by**

1 imprisonment for not more than 1 year or a fine of not more than  
2 \$1,000.00, or both.

3 (3) A person who violates this section for commercial purposes  
4 is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than  
5 5 years or a fine of not more than \$5,000.00, or both.

6 (4) As used in this section:

7 (a) "Commercial purposes" means an activity undertaken with  
8 the purpose of providing a product for monetary compensation.

9 (b) "Drug masking product" includes synthetic urine, human  
10 urine, a substance designed to be added to human urine, or a  
11 substance designed to be added to or used on human hair or oral  
12 fluid, for the purpose of defrauding an alcohol or a drug screening  
13 test.

14 (c) "Synthetic urine" means a substance that is designated to  
15 simulate the composition, chemical properties, physical appearance,  
16 or physical properties of human urine.
