

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 381

The Speaker, on behalf of the entire membership of the House of Representatives, offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution of tribute for the Honorable Gary Eisen.

2 Whereas, It is with gratitude that we honor Representative
3 Gary Eisen as his time in the Michigan House of Representatives
4 comes to a close. He has served his constituents in the Eighty-
5 first District, as well as all of Michigan's citizens, with
6 tenacity and assertiveness; and

7 Whereas, Representative Eisen is a lifelong resident of
8 Michigan. Born in Saint Clair, he graduated from Saint Clair High
9 School, attended Saint Clair Community College, and earned a
10 Welding Technology Degree from Winona Technical Institution.
11 Representative Eisen has shown impressive knowledge and service as
12 the owner of Eisen Inc., a welding and fabrication business, for 46

1 years. Representative Eisen is also a lifelong outdoorsman,
2 enjoying hunting and fishing. He is a dedicated Patriot Life member
3 of the National Rifle Association, a member of the National
4 Shooting Sports Foundation, and a member of the United States
5 Practical Shooters Association. He serves as a concealed pistol
6 license instructor. He is a seventh degree black belt and is a
7 seven-time National Champion in martial arts. Representative Eisen
8 is the devoted husband of Annie and loving father to two children,
9 Bethany and Zachary; and

10 Whereas, Representative Eisen was elected to the Michigan
11 House of Representatives in 2018. He has served dutifully as the
12 vice chair of the Transportation Committee and as a member of the
13 committees on Agriculture; Local Government and Local Municipal
14 Finance; Natural Resources and Outdoor Recreation; Workforce,
15 Trades, and Talent; and Military, Veterans and Homeland Security.
