SUMMARY:

House Bill 4449 would create a new act to designate Vaisakhi as a holiday in Michigan. Specifically, the legislature would declare that April 13 and 14 of each year shall be known as Vaisakhi or Baisakhi, a significant holy day for Sikhs and Hindus.

The bill would have no fiscal impact on the state or local units of government.
