SUMMARY:

House Bill 4544 would create a new act to designate Rosh Hashanah as a holiday in Michigan. Specifically, the legislature would declare that the first and second days of the month of Tishrei, according to the Hebrew calendar, shall be known as Rosh Hashanah.

The bill would have no fiscal impact on the state or local units of government.
