April 11, 2023, Introduced by Rep. Cavitt and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for various state departments and agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023; to provide for certain conditions on appropriations; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

10           Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state  
11 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under  
12 part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023 is  
13 \$1,500,000.00 and total state spending from state sources to be  
14 paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

15           Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized  
16 under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions,  
17 boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made  
18 under this part and part 1 are subject to the management and budget  
19 act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

20           Sec. 203. If the state administrative board, acting under  
21 section 3 of 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.3, transfers funds from an amount  
22 appropriated under this act, the legislature may, by a concurrent  
23 resolution adopted by a majority of the members elected to and  
24 serving in each house, inter-transfer funds within this act for the  
25 particular department, board, commission, office, or institution.

DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

28           Sec. 301. (1) From the funds appropriated in part 1 for  
29 Cornwall Flooding dam repair, the department shall repair the

1 Cornwall Flooding dam in Cheboygan County.

2 (2) Unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for Cornwall  
3 Flooding dam repair are designated as a work project appropriation.  
4 Any unencumbered or unallotted funds shall not lapse at the end of  
5 the fiscal year and shall be available for expenditures for  
6 projects under this section until the projects have been completed.  
7 The following is in compliance with section 451a of the management  
8 and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:

9 (a) The purpose of the project is to repair the Cornwall  
10 Flooding dam in Cheboygan County.

11 (b) The project will be accomplished by utilizing state  
12 employees or contracts with service providers, or both.

13 (c) The total estimated cost of the project is \$1,500,000.00.

14 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2027.
