- 4 of a party, the court finds that the prisoner filed an action
- 5 prohibited under section 5503 or 5505 and 1 of the following
- 6 applies:

- 2 (b) The claim was filed solely to harass the party against3 whom it was filed.
- 4 (c) The prisoner testified falsely or otherwise knowingly5 presents false evidence or information to the court.
