A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled $\mbox{"The social welfare act,"}$

by amending section 105h (MCL 400.105h), as added by 2020 PA 101.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 105h. (1) Beginning October 1, 2020, telemedicine
- 2 Telemedicine services are covered under the medical assistance
- 3 program and Healthy Michigan program if the originating site is an
- 4 in-home or in-school setting, in addition to any other originating
- 5 site allowed in the Medicaid provider manual or any established
- 6 site considered appropriate by the provider.

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- (2) The distant provider or organization is responsible for
 verifying a recipient's identification and program eligibility.
- 3 (3) The distant provider or organization must ensure that the4 information is available to the primary care provider.
 - (4) If a service is provided through telemedicine under this section, the department shall provide the same coverage for that service as if the service involved face-to-face contact between the health care professional and the patient.
 - (5) $\frac{(4)}{(4)}$ As used in this section:

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- (a) "Originating site" means the location of the eligible
 recipient at the time the service being furnished by a
 telecommunications system occurs.
