- 1 Sec. 14a. (1) A person who willfully administers to any
- 2 pregnant individual any medicine, drug, substance, or thing
- 3 whatsoever, or who employs any instrument or other means
- 4 whatsoever, with the intent to perform an abortion, unless the
- 5 abortion is necessary to preserve the life of the pregnant
- 6 individual, is guilty of a felony.

- 1 individual, the person is guilty of manslaughter.
- 2 (3) In a prosecution under this section, it is not necessary
- 3 for the prosecution to prove that no such necessity for the
- 4 abortion existed.
- 5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 6 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 7 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 8 unless Senate Joint Resolution or House Joint Resolution C
- 9 (request no. 03057'23) of the 102nd Legislature becomes a part of
- 10 the state constitution of 1963 as provided in section 1 of article
- 11 XII of the state constitution of 1963.
