

HOUSE BILL NO. 4825

June 15, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Hill, Conlin, Hood, Andrews, Steckloff, Price, Brenda Carter, Arbit, Tsernoglou, Paiz, Rheingans, Morgan, Miller, Byrnes and MacDonell and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 182, entitled
"State police retirement act of 1986,"
by amending section 66 (MCL 38.1666), as added by 2018 PA 674.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 66. (1) A qualified participant, former qualified
2 participant, or refund beneficiary may request a hearing on a claim
3 involving ~~his or her~~ **the participant's or beneficiary's** rights
4 under Tier 2. On written request, the department shall provide for
5 a hearing that must be conducted under chapter 4 of the

1 administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.271 to
2 24.288. An individual may be represented by counsel or other
3 authorized agent at a hearing conducted under this section.

4 (2) Chapters 2, 3, and 5 of the administrative procedures act
5 of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.224 to ~~24.266~~**24.228, 24.231 to**
6 **24.264**, and 24.291 to 24.292, do not apply to the establishment,
7 implementation, administration, operation, investment, or
8 distribution of Tier 2.

9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
10 after the date it is enacted into law.

11 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
12 unless Senate Bill No.____ or House Bill No. 4826 (request no.
13 02687'23) of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into law.
