

HOUSE BILL NO. 5000

September 14, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Wilson and Witwer and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1935 PA 120, entitled

"An act to prescribe a method for the fingerprinting of residents of the state; to provide for the recording and filing of the fingerprints by the central records division of the department of state police; and to impose a fee,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 28.273), as amended by 2019 PA 78.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 3. (1) ~~Until October 1, 2023, the~~ **The** department of state
2 police may charge a fee, not to exceed \$30.00, for taking and
3 processing the fingerprints and completing a criminal record check
4 of a resident of this state when the impression of the fingerprints

1 are requested for employment-related or licensing-related purposes.
2 A fee must not be collected under this subsection if a fee for
3 taking and processing fingerprints is collected under any other
4 law. The fee must not exceed the actual cost of taking and
5 processing the impression of the fingerprints and completing a
6 criminal record check on that person. The fee must be collected and
7 forwarded to the state police by the licensing body or the
8 employer.

9 (2) ~~Until October 1, 2023, the~~ **The** department of state police
10 may charge a fee of \$10.00 for processing and completing a name-
11 based criminal record check. However, a fee must not be charged
12 under this subsection if a fee for processing the name-based
13 criminal record check is charged under any other law or if the
14 requester is a government agency or nonprofit charitable agency
15 performing employment or volunteer employment name-based background
16 checks through the internet criminal history access tool (ICHAT).
