

HOUSE BILL NO. 5076

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled
"The insurance code of 1956,"
(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 3406z.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **Sec. 3406z. (1) An insurer that delivers, issues for delivery,**
2 **or renews in this state a health insurance policy shall provide**
3 **coverage for amino acid-based elemental formula, regardless of the**
4 **delivery methods, for the diagnosis and treatment of any of the**
5 **following:**

6 **(a) Multiple food allergies or protein intolerances.**

1 (b) Eosinophilic disorders.

2 (c) Short bowel syndrome.

3 (2) Subsection (1) only applies if the insured's health care
4 provider has issued a written treatment plan and order stating that
5 the amino acid-based elemental formula is medically necessary for
6 the treatment of the disease or disorder.

7 (3) Coverage under this section must not be subject to
8 deductibles, copayment, or coinsurance requirements, or dollar or
9 durational limits that are less favorable than those for physical
10 illness generally.
