

# HOUSE BILL NO. 5524

February 27, 2024, Introduced by Reps. Carra, Maddock, Friske, Schuette, Markkanen, Smit, DeSana and Fox and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to prohibit members of the legislature from entering into certain nondisclosure agreements.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 1. As used in this act, "nondisclosure agreement" means  
2 an agreement or contract that includes a provision or clause that  
3 provides that a party to the agreement or contract is prohibited  
4 from disclosing, discussing, describing, or commenting upon the  
5 agreement or contract or any of its terms.

6           Sec. 3. (1) Beginning on and after the effective date of this  
7 act, a member of the legislature shall not enter into a

1 nondisclosure agreement regarding any work done in that member's  
2 legislative capacity.

3 (2) A nondisclosure agreement entered into in violation of  
4 this act is void.

5 Sec. 5. This act applies to any nondisclosure agreement that  
6 is entered into, amended, extended, or renewed on or after the  
7 effective date of this act.
