## **SENATE BILL NO. 286**

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 910.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 910. (1) With regard to issuing, denying, suspending, or
revoking a license under this act, the commission shall not
consider a qualified violation if at least 5 years have elapsed
since the act that resulted in the qualified violation.
