## **SENATE BILL NO. 1135**

November 26, 2024, Introduced by Senator POLEHANKI and referred to the Committee on Civil Rights, Judiciary, and Public Safety.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 410d.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 410d. (1) Subject to subsection (2), an individual,
- 2 dealer, firm, partnership, or corporation that intentionally sells
- 3 an imitation firearm is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by
- 4 imprisonment for not more than 93 days or a fine of not more than
- 5 \$1,000.00, or both.
- 6 (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to an imitation firearm that

- 1 is being exported into foreign or interstate commerce.
- 2 (3) As used in this section, "imitation firearm" means any
- 3 device or object made of plastic, wood, metal, or any other
- 4 material that substantially duplicates, or can reasonably be
- 5 perceived to be, a firearm, air rifle, pellet gun, or pneumatic gun
- 6 but that is not actually an operable firearm, air rifle, pellet
- 7 gun, or pneumatic gun. "Imitation firearm" does not include an
- 8 object to which all of the following attributes apply:
- 9 (a) Is colored white, bright red, bright orange, bright
- 10 yellow, bright green, bright blue, bright pink, or bright purple on
- 11 the entire exterior surface or as the predominant color in
- 12 combination with other colors in any pattern, or is constructed
- 13 entirely of transparent or translucent materials that permit
- 14 unmistakable observation of the object's complete contents.
- 15 (b) Has a barrel that is closed for a distance of not less
- 16 than 1/2 inch from the front end of its barrel with the same
- 17 material of which the object is made, unless it is a water gun.
- 18 (c) Has legibly stamped on the object the name of the
- 19 manufacturer or some trade name, mark, or brand by which the
- 20 manufacturer can be readily identified.
- 21 (d) Does not have an attached laser pointer. As used in this
- 22 subdivision, "laser pointer" means any device that emits light
- 23 amplified by the stimulated emission of radiation that is visible
- 24 to the human eye.
- 25 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 26 after the date it is enacted into law.
