

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.150

Reps. Churches, Conlin, Morse, Hoskins, Martus, Aiyash, Breen, Fitzgerald, Glanville, Haadsma, Hill, Hood, Koleszar, Paiz, Rheingans, Rogers, Weiss and Young offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to declare October 13, 2023, as Forging Day in
2 the state of Michigan.

3 Whereas, The forging sector plays a crucial role in driving
4 economic growth, creating job opportunities, and fostering
5 innovation; and

6 Whereas, It is essential to recognize the hard work,
7 dedication, and ingenuity of the individuals working in the forging
8 industry; and

9 Whereas, By designating a specific day to honor and showcase
10 forging achievements, we can raise awareness about its importance
11 and inspire the next generation of manufacturers; and

1 Whereas, Friday, October 13, 2023, provides an ideal
2 opportunity to celebrate Forging Day due to its proximity to the
3 end of the calendar year and aligning with the traditionally
4 celebrated Manufacturing Day events; now, therefore, be it

5 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
6 this legislative body declare October 13, 2023, as Forging Day in
7 the state of Michigan. We encourage businesses, educational
8 institutions, and communities to organize events and activities
9 that highlight the positive impact of the forging industry; and be
10 it further

11 Resolved, That we pledge to collaborate with relevant
12 stakeholders to promote Forging Day and actively participate in
13 related initiatives, use its communication channels and platforms
14 to spread awareness about Forging Day and its significance, and
15 advocate for government recognition and support for the forging
16 sector through policy measures and initiatives.
