- 3 Whereas, This observation originated in 1968 as Hispanic
- 4 Heritage Week as approved by President Lyndon Johnson, and was
- 5 expanded by President Ronald Reagan to encompass the thirty-days of
- 6 September 15 through October 15; Hispanic Heritage Month was
- 7 enacted into law in 1988 as Public Law 100-402; and
- 8 Whereas, Michigan is fortunate to count among its population a
- 9 great number of residents of Spanish and Latin American heritage
- 10 whose contributions to education, agriculture, law, science, and

other professions, also extend to the Michigan workforce and the 1 2 strengthening of our state's economy and representation in state 3 and local governments; and Whereas, Hispanic Heritage Month recognizes the various many 4 histories and accomplishments of our Hispanic and Latino citizens, 5 and celebrates with special events highlighting their diverse 6 7 cultures and communities; now, therefore, be it 8 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of this legislative body declare September 15-October 15, 2024, as 9

Hispanic Heritage Month in the state of Michigan.
