Senators Huizenga, Outman, Santana and Theis offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to urge Congress to fund the construction of a

2 new air traffic control tower for the Gerald R. Ford International

- 4 Whereas, The Gerald R. Ford International Airport, located in
- 5 Cascade Township near Grand Rapids, Michigan, is the largest
- 6 commercial airport in western Michigan and second largest airport
- 7 in the state. This airport has been ranked by the Federal Aviation
- 8 Administration as one of the fastest growing airports in the United
- 9 States. The Gerald R. Ford International Airport, originally named
- 10 the Kent County Airport, was built in 1963 and is in desperate need
- 11 of an update to its air traffic control tower; and
- 12 Whereas, The current air traffic control tower in use at the

- 1 Gerald R. Ford International Airport is over six decades old,
- 2 making it the second-oldest control tower in the nation's top 100
- 3 markets. Recent terminal upgrades mark this airport as dedicated to
- 4 setting the bar high regarding the quality of the services it
- 5 provides. Securing funding for a new air traffic control tower
- 6 would ensure that the Gerald R. Ford International Airport
- 7 maintains this trend; now, therefore, be it
- 8 Resolved by the Senate, That we urge Congress to fund the
- 9 construction of a new air traffic control tower for the Gerald R.
- 10 Ford International Airport; and be it further
- 11 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 12 President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United
- 13 States House of Representatives, and the members of the Michigan
- 14 congressional delegation.
